IWIN Initiative

IWIN (I'm Worth It Now), a CWL initiative will be holding a Red Sand Prayer Service before all masses at both Assumption and Resurrection the weekend of April 2/3. This service is in recognition of the victims of human trafficking - an atrocity that is occurring right here in Edmonton. The sand that we will place in the cracks of the sidewalk is a reminder that we cannot merely walk over the most marginalized members of our community - those who "fall through" the cracks of society. The red symbolizes the blood of Christ poured out for all His children.

In addition to prayer, IWIN and the CWL, provide survival backpacks with basic necessities for these victims as they enter wrap-around programs on their journey to healing. This part of the program has just launched in Edmonton working in collaboration with CEASE and ALERT. Vocal Workshop

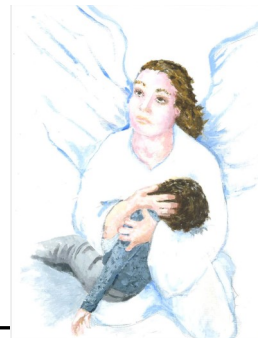

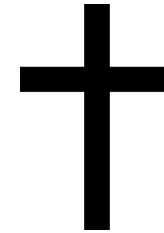
