

Third Sunday of Easter

The Apostles have returned to Galilee and decide to go fishing. They have been fishing all night, they are hungry, and Jesus invites them to “Come, have breakfast.” This is a repeat of the first miracle He performed when He first called Peter. The Apostles don’t know it is Jesus at first, or perhaps He has prevented them from recognizing Him. When He repeats the miracle, however, John knows Him immediately and Peter in his excitement jumps in the water to meet the Lord he loves.

Christ shows us how to love. With our very lives, yes. Being willing to sacrifice everything for others, yes. But much more often, love will look much more mundane and ordinary. It will look like breakfast.

How is Christ showing you He loves you today? Maybe an unexpected phone call from an old friend, maybe a green light when you need it most. Maybe it is simply the strength to open our eyes and get out of bed. Don’t forget to thank Him. And don’t forget to be a practical instrument of His love for others in your life today.

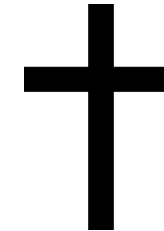
